The following is a summary of the documents and fees that must be submitted for registration of a professional corporation or professional association:

- (1) 1 original and 1 copy of the Articles of Incorporation. A template for the articles can be found on the Corporations page of the Secretary of State's website <http://www.secretary.state.nc.us/corporations/>.
- (2) 1 original Application for Certificate of Registration (form PC-1, attached). Please note that the application must be notarized.
- (3) \$50.00 check payable to the N.C. State Bar.

If the name of the PA or PC is approved, we will return your original articles and a Certification of Registration (form PC-2), prepared by the N.C. State Bar, as required by the Secretary of State.

You must then submit your original articles and the Certification of Registration to the Secretary of State's Office, Corporations Division. Once processed by the Secretary of State's Office, you will receive your "certified articles" from them.

Please send a copy of the certified articles to the N.C. State Bar (address above) to receive your Certificate of Registration (form PC-3) from the N.C. State Bar, to finalize the process.
