

## Amending a Certificate of Authority Interstate/International Law Firm

The following document and payment must be submitted to the North Carolina State Bar to amend a Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in North Carolina (e.g. change the name of a firm, change the responsible NC-licensed attorney, etc.)

1. A copy of the Application for Amended Certificate of Authority: Form PC-03 for a PA/PC; Form PLLC-03 for a PLLC; Form LLP-03 for an LLP.

2. A check or money order for the \$20.00 processing fee (payable to NC State Bar.)
