This matter being before the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a petition for reinstatement filed on October 24, 1985 by Amos E. Link, Jr.; and

IT APPEARING from a review of the CONSENT ORDER OF DISCIPLINE filed on June 7, 1985 that Petitioner was ordered suspended for three years with all but 120 days of said suspension to be stayed upon certain conditions; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING from the petition that Petitioner has met the conditions for the remainder of his suspension to be stayed; and
