TO: The Council of The North Carolina State Bar

I, Helen E. Lewis, hereby tender my license to practice and desire to resign from The North Carolina State Bar. My resignation is tendered freely and voluntarily, is not the result of coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the implications of submitting the resignation.

I am aware that there are presently pending investigations or other proceedings regarding allegations that I have been guilty of misconduct, to wit, misappropriation of client funds relating to the loan closing on February 28, 1995, between Kenneth Vendel and Cheryl Gobble (Grievance No. 95G0349(II)).

I acknowledge that the material facts upon which the complaints are predicated are true. I am submitting my resignation because I know that if charges were predicated upon the misconduct under investigation, I could not successfully defend against them.

I am aware that the N. C. State Bar Council will consider this matter at 9:00 A.M. on Friday, April 14, 1995, and that I have the right to be present. I hereby waive formal notice of this hearing.
