ORDER

Formal findings of fact were waived and pursuant to Section 9 of Article IX, Discipline and Disbarment of Attorneys, the undersigned Hearing Committee of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission hereby issues the following Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendant, Edmund A. Liles, be suspended from the practice of law in the State of North Carolina for a period of six months.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Edmund A. Liles be taxed with the costs of this hearing.




IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the license of the Defendant shall be suspended during the period of any incarceration that
