ORDER




IT IS ORDERED that the defendant, Renn Drum, Jr. be suspended from the practice of law in the State of North Carolina for a period of one (1) year from and including the date of November 13, 1978.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Renn Drum, Jr. be taxed with the costs of this hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Renn Drum, Jr. may apply for reinstatement to the Council of the North Carolina State Bar at its October 1979 Meeting pursuant to Section 25, Article 9, of the Rules and Regulations of The North Carolina State Bar, with the understanding that reinstatement will not occur before one (1) year from the ^{effective} date his license is suspended hereunder.
