

ORDER

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard and being heard before the undersigned Hearing Committee of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission of The North Carolina State Bar upon the Petition for Reinstatement of Renn Drum, Jr. and upon written stipulation between the parties; and

IT APPEARING to the Committee that the original intent of the Order of April 27, 1979, was that the Defendant was to be suspended from the practice of law for one (1) year from and including November 13, 1978; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the parties have stipulated and agreed that the original Order should be self-executing and that the Defendant should be reinstated effective November 13, 1979, upon satisfying the Secretary and the Office of the Counsel of The North Carolina State Bar that he has complied with the terms of the suspension imposed and has paid the costs of the action.

IT, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the final paragraph of the April 27, 1979 Order be and is hereby stricken; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon compliance with the terms set out above, that the Defendant be reinstated to the practice of law in North Carolina on November 13, 1979.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the action of the Committee shall be submitted to the Council of The North Carolina State Bar for approval at its next meeting.
