ORDER OF THE COUNCIL

This matter coming on to be heard and being heard by the Council of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to Rule 17 of Article IX of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar on April 16, 1982, upon the tender of Surrender of License of Stanley A. Gertzman with A. Root Edmonson representing the North Carolina State Bar and Wallace S. Osborne representing Stanley A. Gertzman; and

It appearing that Stanley A. Gertzman filed an affidavit pursuant to Rule 17 (1) of Article IX and a further stipulation of facts upon which the Council of the North Carolina State Bar bases its findings of fact and conclusions of law as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On August 11, 1981, in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of North Carolina held in Charlotte, North Carolina, a jury verdict of guilty was returned with reference to Counts Four and Five of an indictment Docket No. C-CR-81-26 alleging that Stanley A. Gertzman made a materially false statement and report in connection with a loan made to PDC (a corporation) by the City National Bank, Charlotte, N. C. in violation of Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 1014. Verdict as to Count Four was subsequently set aside.
2. Stanley A. Gertzman began winding down his law practice on November 3, 1981 and completely ceased the practice of law on January 19, 1982.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The crime for which Stanley A. Gertzman was convicted is a "serious crime" as defined by Rule 3 (30) of Article IX.
2. The affidavit filed by Stanley A. Gertzman meets the requirements of Rule 17 of Article IX and his tender of surrender of license should be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


A. The tender of surrender of license of Stanley A. Gertzman be accepted.

B. Stanley A. Gertzman is hereby suspended from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months from January 19, 1982.

C. Reinstatement of the license of Stanley A. Gertzman shall be automatic upon compliance with the period of suspension.

D. The costs of this action be taxed against Stanley A. Gertzman.
