This matter coming on to be heard and being heard by the Council of The North Carolina State Bar pursuant to Rule 17 of Article IX of the Rules and Regulations of The North Carolina State Bar on January 14, 1983, upon the tender of surrender of license of Daniel M. Work, Jr., and

It further appearing that the Council received an affidavit of Daniel M. Work, Jr., made pursuant to Section 17(1) of Article IX of the Rules and Regulations of The North Carolina State Bar, and:

BASED UPON the affidavit of Daniel M. Work, Jr., the Council makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On November 18, 1982, Daniel M. Work, Jr. pleaded guilty to five counts of violations of N.C.G.S. § 14-90 and three counts of violations of N.C.G.S. § 14-100.
2. On December 17, 1982, Daniel M. Work, Jr. was convicted of five felony counts of embezzlement and three felony counts of false pretense pursuant to such plea.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The crimes for which Daniel M. Work, Jr. was convicted were "serious crimes" as defined by Rule 3(30) of Article IX.

2. The affidavit filed by Daniel M. Work, Jr. meets the requirements of Rule 17 of Article IX and his tender of surrender of license should be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND SECONDED, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

A. The tender of surrender of license of Daniel M. Work, Jr. be accepted.

B. Daniel M. Work, Jr. is hereby DISBARRED.

C. The costs of this action be taxed against Daniel M. Work, Jr.
