ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

This matter was heard by the Council of The North Carolina State Bar at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 13, 1984, upon petition for the reinstatement of the license by Reginald Lee Frazier. Based upon the matters presented to the Council, the Council makes the following Findings of Fact.

1. On the 8th day of September, 1981, a hearing committee of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission entered an order suspending the law license of Reginald Lee Frazier for one year effective thirty days after service of the order on Mr. Frazier or thirty days after affirmation of the order on appeal.

2. On June 6, 1983, the Court of Appeals' decision affirming the order of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission was certified to The North Carolina State Bar. Under the Rules of The North Carolina State Bar, the effective date of this suspension was thirty days after the certification date by the Court of Appeals, July 6, 1983.

3. On July 8, 1983, Reginald Lee Frazier submitted an affidavit to the Secretary of The North Carolina State Bar stating that he had complied with the provisions of Rule 24 of the Discipline and Disbarment Rules and enclosing copies of the letters to each of his clients notifying them that he had been suspended for a period of one year and could no longer handle the client's legal matters.

4. Also on July 8, 1983, Reginald Lee Frazier forwarded to the Secretary of The North Carolina State Bar his law license and membership card. These have been in the possession of the Secretary of The North Carolina State Bar since July 8, 1984.

5. On May 25, 1984, Reginald Lee Frazier petitioned The North Carolina State Bar for the reinstatement of his law license. This petition was filed in the office of The North Carolina State Bar on May 29, 1984.

6. The Office of Counsel of The North Carolina State Bar has no evidence that Reginald Lee Frazier engaged in the practice of law during the period between July 6, 1983, the effective date of the suspension, and July 6, 1984.

7. Reginald Lee Frazier has paid the cost paid to him in the proceeding leading to his suspension.

BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS OF FACT, the Council makes the following CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. Reginald Lee Frazier has complied with the provisions of Rule 24 of the Discipline and Disbarment Rules of The North Carolina State Bar, which Rules are a condition precedent to reinstatement.

2. Reginald Lee Frazier has complied with the conditions of the order of discipline suspending him for one year effective July 6, 1983. Reginald Lee Frazier has met the burden of proof required under the provisions of Rule 25 of the Discipline and Disbarment Rules of The North Carolina State Bar for reinstatement of his law license following a suspension from the practice.


BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, the Council hereby enters the following ORDER:

1. Reginald Lee Frazier is hereby reinstated to the practice of law effective July 13, 1984.

2. The Secretary is directed to return the law license and membership card of Reginald Lee Frazier to Mr. Frazier immediately.

3. The costs of this Petition for Reinstatement are taxed to Reginald Lee Frazier.
