ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Roland C. Braswell has filed a Petition for Reinstatement to practice law in the State of North Carolina.

The record reveals that Mr. Braswell was suspended from the practice of law for a period of 90 days on the 13th day of September, 1982, which became effective on June 6, 1984, after the exhaustion of all appeals: and more than 90 days have expired since the effective date of the Order of Suspension.

Investigation by the office of The North Carolina State Bar demonstrates that Mr. Braswell has satisfied all conditions of the suspension by:
a) complying with Section 24 of the rules, b) compliance with all applicable orders of the Disciplinary Hearing Panel, c) and abstention from the Unauthorized Practice of Law during the period of suspension.

No reason appears why the Petitioner should not be reinstated.

The Secretary, by authority of Section 25 of the Rules and Regulations of The North Carolina State Bar, relative to discipline and disbarment, does hereby order that Roland C. Braswell be and is hereby reinstated to practice law in the courts of the State of North Carolina.
