ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard upon the request of Herbert P. Scott to surrender voluntarily to this Court his license to practice law in the State of North Carolina because of incapacity. Herbert P. Scott represented through signed letter to this Court that he has an undiagnosed disability which he acknowledges affects his capacity to practice law and that he considers this disability to support his transfer from active to inactive status. Ms. Scott further consents to the Court's entering this Order accepting his voluntary surrender of his license, finding of disability, and transfer of him to inactive status until such time as he presents to the Court evidence which satisfies the Court that he has regained his capacity to practice law.

The Court having reviewed the letter from Mr. Scott and such evidence as this Court deems necessary to support this Order, the Court finds that there is a factual basis for this determination that Mr. Scott is now disabled and for the entry of this Order finding him to be disabled and that there is further a factual basis for the exercise of this Court's inherent power to transfer Mr. Scott to an inactive status because of his disability.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Herbert P. Scott be and hereby is transferred to inactive status as a member of the North Carolina State Bar, and this transfer is effective

immediately. Upon the entry of this Order the Court acknowledges that Mr. Scott has surrendered to the Court his license to practice law. Upon overcoming his disability and regaining capacity, Mr. Scott may petition a Resident Superior Court Judge of the Fifth Judicial District for transfer to active status and upon proof satisfactory to a Resident Superior Court Judge of the Fifth Judicial District that Mr. Scott has regained his capacity to practice law, the said judge may enter an Order transferring Mr. Scott back to active status.

A copy of this Order shall be served upon Mr. Scott and upon the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar.
