RESTORATION OF LICENSE

In the matter of Bernice R. Batts, Mooresville, upon order of the Council on July 16, 1976, Mr. Batts was reinstated as an attorney to practice law in this State. His license was suspended in January of 1972.

In the matter of Phillip R. Matthews, Newton, by order of the Council on July 16, 1976, Mr. Matthews was reinstated as an attorney at law effective August 1, 1976. His license was previously suspended in January of 1976 for one year with the right to petition for reinstatement in July of 1976.
