 - a. Prior to reinstatement, Dow M. Spaulding shall successfully complete the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination.
 - b. Prior to reinstatement, Dow M. Spaulding shall successfully complete a regularly scheduled bar examination administered by the North Carolina Board of Law Examiners.
2. Petitioner is taxed with the costs of this reinstatement proceeding.
