

This matter is before the undersigned Chairperson of the North Carolina State Bar's Grievance Committee pursuant to 27 NCAC 1B §.0118(g); with Carolin Bakewell representing the North Carolina State Bar and Everett L. Henry appearing pro se. With the consent of the member and the deputy counsel, the undersigned makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The North Carolina State Bar is a body duly organized under the laws of North Carolina and is the proper party to consent to this proceeding under the authority granted it in Chapter 84 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar promulgated thereunder.
2. Everett L. Henry was admitted to the North Carolina State Bar on or about August 7, 1954 and is an Attorney at Law licensed to practice in North Carolina, subject to the rules, regulations, and the Revised Rules of Professional Conduct of the North Carolina State Bar and the laws of the State of North Carolina.
3. Everett L. Henry actively engaged in the practice of law in the State of North Carolina and maintained a law office in Lumberton, North Carolina.
4. Everett L. Henry currently suffers from a heart condition and kidney failure requiring dialysis three days per week that significantly impairs his professional judgment, performance, or competence as an attorney.
5. Everett L. Henry consents to being transferred to disability inactive status.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact, the undersigned makes the following:


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to 27 NCAC 1B §.0118(g), the proper parties have consented to Everett L. Henry being transferred to disability inactive status. Such a transfer would serve to stay any and all grievances pending against Mr. Henry.
2. Everett L. Henry is disabled within the meaning of 27 NCAC 1B §.0103(19).


THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED:


1. Everett L. Henry is transferred to disability inactive status.
