



Order Granting Stay

For good cause shown, the Defendant's Motion for Stay of the effective date of the Order of Discipline entered by the Disciplinary Hearing Commission on June 8, 2006 pursuant to Rule 62 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure pending disposition of Defendant's appeal of right of said order to the North Carolina Court of Appeals is hereby granted.
