

ORDER
OF DISBARMENT

THIS MATTER coming before the undersigned Chair of The Disciplinary Hearing Commission pursuant to 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0117(d) upon an affidavit of surrender of license executed by Charles D. Blackwell II ("Blackwell") dated February 14, 2007 and filed in the offices of the North Carolina State Bar on March 21, 2007.

Based upon the pleadings and the record, the undersigned makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Defendant was licensed to practice law in North Carolina in 2002.
2. Defendant's address of record with the North Carolina State Bar is 1407 Coach Road, Reidsville, NC 27320.
3. Defendant tendered a plea of guilty in the United States District Court for the Middle District of North Carolina to one count of Possession of Child Pornography, a felony, and Defendant was sentenced for his criminal offense to 57 months in prison.
4. On December 8, 2006, the North Carolina State Bar filed a formal complaint against Defendant alleging he violated the Revised Rules of Professional Conduct based upon his felony conviction.
5. Defendant has indicated his wish to consent to disbarment by filing an affidavit with the Disciplinary Hearing Commission. The affidavit, while erroneously addressed to the Council of the North Carolina State Bar, nevertheless meets all requirements set forth in 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0117(a)(1), (2), (3), (4) and (d).

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact the undersigned makes the following

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0108 provides that the Chair has the power and duty to enter orders disbaring members by consent.

2. Defendant's affidavit meets all requirements set forth in 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0117(a)(1), (2), (3), (4) and (d) and the facts upon which the affidavit is predicated warrant Defendant's disbarment.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the undersigned Chair of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission enters the following

ORDER


1. The surrender of the license of Charles D. Blackwell II is hereby accepted.

2. Charles D. Blackwell II is DISBARRED from the practice of law in North Carolina effective upon the entry of this order with the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar.

3. Charles D. Blackwell II shall comply with the provisions of 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0124 of the State Bar Discipline and Disability Rules and shall surrender his license and permanent membership card to the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar along with the affidavit required by 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0124 of the State Bar Discipline and Disability Rules.

4. The costs of this action are taxed against the Defendant.
