

THIS MATTER is before the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a Petition for Reinstatement filed by Allen W. Rogers ("Rogers") on March 21, 2007.

Based upon the petition and a review of the records of the North Carolina State Bar, the Secretary makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 22, 2006, a hearing committee of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission ("DHC") entered Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order of Discipline by Consent in 05 DHC 26 ("Order of Discipline") suspending Rogers from the practice of law for three years with the possibility of two years of the suspension being stayed if Rogers complied with certain conditions.
2. On March 21, 2007, Rogers filed a petition for reinstatement showing that he had satisfied the conditions of the Order of Discipline.
3. Counsel for the North Carolina State Bar did not file an objection to Rogers' petition.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Secretary makes the following

CONCLUSION OF LAW


1. The Petitioner, Allen W. Rogers, has satisfied the requirements set out in 27 NCAC 1B, § .0125(b) and is entitled to reinstatement of his license to practice law in this jurisdiction.

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Allen W. Rogers is hereby reinstated to the active practice of law in North Carolina as of the date of this order.
