

Instructions for North Carolina State Bar Certification for Law Student Supervised Practice (Individual Application)

Law school students may apply for certification pursuant to the North Carolina State Bar Rules Governing the Practical Training of Law Students (27 N.C. Admin. Code 1C.0200 et seq.) using the following link: [North Carolina State Bar Law Student Certification - Individual Application](#)

Prior to completing the application, students should review and be familiar with the aforementioned Rules Governing the Practical Training of Law Students as well as the Rules of Professional Conduct.

Students must submit all required materials at the time of application, including completed/executed versions of all required forms (e.g., the student's form, the supervising attorney's form, and the law school representative's form) in PDF format. The required forms can be found on the [State Bar's website](#).

Applications that do not provide all required forms will not be processed. Incomplete applications will be deleted. If a student submits an incomplete application, the application will be deleted and not processed; the student will need to submit a new, complete application to proceed to processing.
