

APPLICATION FOR TRADE NAME REGISTRATION

This is an application to the North Carolina State Bar, pursuant to North Carolina Rule of Professional Conduct 7.5(a), for the registration of a trade name for use by a law firm.^{1 2} Registration of a trade name may be denied, or a remedial disclaimer may be required, if a trade name is potentially misleading.³ Fill in all of the blanks below (attach additional sheets if necessary). If an inquiry is not applicable, please write “not applicable” in the blank. Incomplete applications will be returned.

1. State the requested trade name. The trade name may not include a professional entity designation (PC, PA or PLLC), because the inclusion of an entity designation in a trade name is potentially misleading in violation of Rule 7.5(a).⁴

2. State the official/legal name of the law firm.

6. If the trade name includes the name of a lawyer who is deceased or retired, state the full name of the lawyer(s), whether the lawyer(s) is deceased or retired, the dates that the lawyer(s) was affiliated with the firm, and the position(s) that the lawyer held with the firm (e.g., partner, shareholder, of counsel, etc.).

1 The State Bar makes every effort to avoid the registration of trade names that are the same or deceptively similar to trade names that are already registered with the State Bar. However, State Bar registration does not provide legal protection from infringement.

2 See N.C. Gen. Stat. §66-68(a) and (e) with regard to the duty to file a certificate of assumed name with register of deeds in each county in which business is conducted under an assumed name.

3 The use of the names of deceased former members of a firm and the use of such designations as “Law Offices of John Doe,” “Smith and Associates,” “Jones Law Firm,” and the like, does not render the firm name a trade name. Rule 7.5(a).

4 The NC Secretary of State’s Office requested this prohibition to avoid misleading members of the public who access its records for PCs, PAs, and PLLCs.

7. List the practice areas of the law firm.

8. Explain why the trade name is appropriate for your law firm.⁵

9. List all other trade names that the law firm has registered with the State Bar and the date of registration.

10. State whether the trade name will be used for all legal services offered by the law firm. If not, describe the services that will be offered under the trade name and how the public will be advised of the relationship between the law firm and the division of the law firm operating under the trade name.

11. State the name, position, and telephone number of the person completing this application.
