

## Withdrawal of a Certificate of Authority Interstate/International Law Firm

If the interstate/internation law firm was required to maintain a Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in North Carolina because it maintained an office in NC, please complete steps 1 and 2 below:

1. File an Application for Certificate of Withdrawal/Cancellation with the NC SOS along with their applicable fee. Complete Form BE-08 for a PA/PC; Form L-14 for a PLLC; Form LLP-04 for an LLP.

2. Forward a copy of the file-stamped Certificate of Withdrawal/Cancellation to:

If the interstate/international law firm does not have a Certificate of Authority from the NC SOS, please notify the NC State Bar in writing on firm letterhead (via mail or email) that the firm no longer meets the criteria for registration with the NC State Bar as an interstate/international law firm. This must be done on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> to avoid the renewal fee for the following year.
