

To Change the Name or Otherwise Amend Articles of Organization for a PLLC

Articles of Amendment must be filed with the NC Secretary of State (NC SOS) to change the name of a professional limited liability company (PLLC) or to change any other information on the original articles filed with the NC SOS. The following document and fees must be mailed to the NC State Bar **prior** to filing Articles of Amendment with the NC SOS:

(1) One copy of the completed Articles of Amendment (please retain the original for filing with the NC SOS). You can find the NC SOS Articles of Amendment (Form L-17) on their website:

(2) \$20.00 check or money order payable to NC State Bar.

Search your entity's name on the NC SOS website, then click on the "upload a PDF filing" icon (highlighted below) to the right of your entity's name and follow the instructions.



The NC SOS will return the filed/date-stamped articles of amendment to you via mail or email. Upon receipt, please email the filed articles to pmcwilliams@ncbar.gov to receive your updated Certificate of Registration via email.
