

Registration and Incorporation of a Professional Limited Liability Company

Application processing time is 3-5 business days from date of receipt.

<u>Before</u> filing Articles of Organization with the NC Secretary of State (NC SOS,) you must register a professional limited liability company (PLLC) with the North Carolina State Bar. The following documents and fees must be submitted to register a PLLC with the NC State Bar:

- (1) The original NC State Bar Application for Certificate of Registration, attached. Please note that the application must be notarized.
- (2) One copy of the completed Articles of Organization (please retain the original for filing with the NC SOS). You can find NC SOS Articles of Organization (Form PLLC-02) on their website: https://www.sosnc.gov/forms/by_title/ Business Registration Business Entities Common
- (3) \$50.00 check or money order payable to NC State Bar.

If there is any impediment to approving the registration, you will be advised of the problem and given an opportunity to correct it.

If the registration is approved, we will email the Certification of Registration to you. A copy of the certification must be submitted along with your articles of organization to the NC SOS. You can file these documents through the NC SOS website: https://www.sosnc.gov/

Click the button to login or create an account with the NC SOS. Select "<u>Limited Liability Company</u>" for the type of entity you are creating. The NC SOS will return the filed/date-stamped articles to you via mail or email. Upon receipt, please email the filed articles to pmcwilliams@ncbar.gov to receive your Certificate of Registration. You must renew your Certificate of Registration annually through your NC State Bar portal. You will receive an email notice when it is time to renew.
