Registration and Incorporation of a Professional Corporation or a Professional Association

Application processing time is 3-5 business days from date of receipt.

Before filing Articles of Incorporation with the NC Secretary of State (NC SOS,) you must register a professional corporation (PC) or professional association (PA) with the North Carolina State Bar. The following documents and fees must be submitted to register a PC or PA with the NC State Bar:

- (1) The original NC State Bar Application for Certificate of Registration, attached.
- (2) One copy of the completed Articles of Incorporation (please retain the original for filing with the NC SOS). You can find NC SOS Articles of Incorporation (Form PC-05) on their website: https://www.sosnc.gov/forms/by_title/Business_Registration_Business_Entities_Common
- (3) \$50.00 check or money order payable to NC State Bar. Fee is non-refundable upon processing of application.

Name of the Firm: Pursuant to 27 N.C.A.C. Chapter 1E § .0102(a), the name of the firm must include the owner's full or surname and no additional wording other than the very basic type of service being rendered (e.g "John Doe Law," "Doe Law Firm," "Jane Doe Legal," "The Law Office(s) of Jane Doe.") Firm names may not include any legal specializations, nor any city/state locations.

If there is any impediment to approving the registration, you will be advised of the problem and given an opportunity to correct it.

If the registration is approved, we will email the Certification of Registration to you. A copy of the certification must be submitted along with your articles of incorporation to the NC SOS. Detailed instructions will be included with the email for filing online through the NC SOS website.

The NC SOS will return the filed/date-stamped articles to you via mail or email. Upon receipt, please email the filed articles to pmcwilliams@ncbar.gov to receive your Certificate of Registration via email. You must renew your Certificate of Registration annually through your NC State Bar portal. You will receive an email notice when it is time to renew.

****Please Note:** If your firm maintains offices in NC and one or more jurisdictions outside NC, and if any non-NC licensed attorney practices on behalf of your firm in state court matters in their home state, your firm must register as an Interstate/International Law Firm.
