

INITIAL WEBSITE DOCUMENT PROVIDER REGISTRATION

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-2.2, all persons, firms, or companies that operate a Website that offers consumers access to interactive software that generates a legal document based on the consumer's answers to questions presented by the software that complies with the requirements of the statute must register with the North Carolina State Bar before commencing operation in North Carolina.

Registration does not constitute approval by the North Carolina State Bar. The operation of the Website must comply with all pertinent laws, including the prohibition on the unauthorized practice of law in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-2.1-10. Registration does not constitute agreement or acquiescence by the State Bar that the operation of the Website complies with all laws including N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-2.1 or 2.2.

A Website provider must file an initial registration with the State Bar and must renew the registration annually based on the date of the initial registration. The initial registration fee is \$100.00. The annual renewal fee is \$50.00.

	The provider does not disclaim any warranties or liability and does not limit the recovery of damages or other remedies by the consumer.
	The provider does not require the consumer to agree to jurisdiction or venue in any state other than North Carolina for the resolution of disputes between the provider and the consumer.
	The provider has a consumer satisfaction process. All consumer concerns involving the unauthorized practice of law made to the provider shall be referred to the North Carolina State Bar. The consumer satisfaction process must be conspicuously displayed on the provider's Web site.
