



## **Dissolution of a Professional Limited Liability Company For Law Firms Only**

The following document and fee must be submitted to dissolve a law firm organized as a professional limited liability company (PLLC):

1. Complete the Articles of Dissolution and file with the NC Secretary of State's Corporations division along with their applicable filing fee first. The Articles of Dissolution form can be found on the NC Secretary of State's website. Click "Limited Liability Companies" and select Form L-07

2. Once you receive the filed/date-stamped Articles of Dissolution from the NC Secretary of State, mail a copy of the filed articles with a check or money order payable to NC State Bar for the \$20.00 fee\*\* to:

**\*\* If the law firm was suspended at the time of the filing of your articles of dissolution, you must include an additional \$35.00 (\$25.00 renewal fee + \$10.00 late fee from the year of suspension) to remove the firm from a suspended status. Total due to the NC State Bar will be \$55.00.**
