WITH PREJUDICE

NOW COMES, the Council of the North Carolina State Bar and says the following:


On July 12, 1978 the Grievance Committee of the North Carolina State Bar found probable cause against the above-named defendant for a grievance submitted by the Jay Freeman Wilfong. That the defendant handled a case in federal court in such a manner that it had to be dismissed and that the defendant negligently handled a divorce action for complainant Wilfong.

That defendant tendered his Affidavit of Resignation from the North Carolina State Bar on the 26th day of March, 1979 as a result of an investigation by the State Bar and others of his commission of the crime of embezzlement. Defendant pled guilty to the crime of embezzlement in the Superior Court of Catawba County on February 13, 1979 and is presently serving a term of four (4) years in the North Carolina Department of Correction.

That the defendant was disbarred by the Council of the North Carolina State Bar on April 13, 1979.

THEREFORE, Council for the State Bar under Rule 41 of the Rules of Civil Procedure for the State of North Carolina hereby enters a Voluntary Dismissal with Prejudice.
