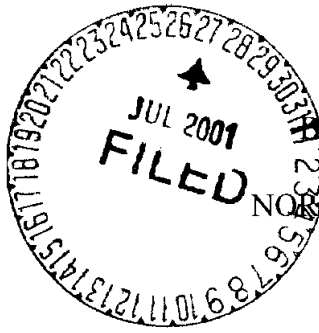

THIS MATTER coming on to be heard and being heard by the Council of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to 27 N.C. Admin. Code Chapter 1, Subchapter B, § .0117(a) of the State Bar Discipline & Disability Rules upon an affidavit of tender of surrender of license executed by Jennifer D. Brock on May 30, 2001, and filed in the offices of the North Carolina State Bar on May 31, 2001.

Based upon the affidavit, the Council finds that Jennifer D. Brock's conduct of misappropriating client funds is grounds for discipline pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-28(b)(2) in that Jennifer D. Brock violated Rules 8.4(b) and (c) of the North Carolina Revised Rules of Professional Conduct.

WHEREFORE, upon Motion made and duly seconded, the Council enters the following Order:

1. The tender of surrender of license of Jennifer D. Brock is hereby accepted.
2. Jennifer D. Brock is hereby is DISBARRED from the practice of law in North Carolina.
3. Jennifer D. Brock shall comply with the provisions of 27 N.C.A.C. Chapter 1, Subchapter B, § .0124 of the State Bar Discipline & Disability Rules and shall surrender his license and permanent membership card to the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar along with the affidavit required by § .0124 of the State Bar Discipline & Disability Rules.
4. The costs of this action are taxed against Jennifer D. Brock.

AFFIDAVIT



JENNIFER D. BROCK, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am an attorney presently licensed in the State of North Carolina although my license is presently under suspension, having been licensed since August 18, 1984,
2. I am subject to an investigation into allegations of misconduct and, to the best of my knowledge, no formal complaint has been filed before the Disciplinary Hearing Commission of the North Carolina State Bar,
3. I hereby tender my license to practice law. I am delivering it herewith to the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar for transmittal to the North Carolina State Bar Counsel,
4. I desire to resign from the North Carolina State Bar and such resignation is freely and voluntarily rendered, it is not the result of coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the implication of submitting this resignation,
5. I am aware that there is presently pending an investigation or other proceedings regarding allegations that I have been guilty of misconduct in the administration of trust funds including misappropriation thereof,
6. I acknowledge that the material facts upon which the investigation is predicated are true,
7. My resignation is being submitted because I know that if charges were predicated upon the misconduct under investigation, I could not successfully defend against them.
8. This affidavit is executed and tendered pursuant to the provisions of Section .0117 of sub chapter 1 B of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar.

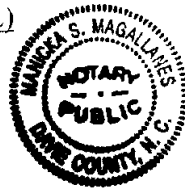
