Based upon the Affidavit of Surrender of Law License submitted to the court by Hunter, the court makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Hunter failed to report a foreign bank account to the Internal Revenue Service as required by 31 U.S.C. 5314.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the court makes the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. By failing to report a foreign bank account to the Internal Revenue Service as required by 31 U.S.C. 5314, Hunter violated Rule of Professional Conduct 8.4(c).
2. Hunter's misconduct constitutes grounds for discipline pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. Section 84-28(b)(2).


IT IS NOW, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

1. R. C. Hunter is DISBARRED from the practice of law in North Carolina.
2. Hunter shall comply with the provisions of Subchapter B, Section .0124 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar and shall surrender his license and

permanent membership card to the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar along with the affidavit required by Subchapter B, Section .0124.


3. The costs and administrative fees of this action are taxed against Hunter.





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
AFFIDAVIT OF SURRENDER
OF LAW LICENSE

R. C. Hunter, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

1. I desire to resign and hereby tender my license to practice law in North Carolina pursuant to the provisions of Section .0117 of the North Carolina State Bar Discipline and Disability Rules, 27 N.C. Admin. Code Chapter 1, Subchapter B, Section .0117.
2. My resignation is freely and voluntarily rendered. It is not the result of coercion or duress. I am fully aware of the implication of submitting my resignation.
3. I am aware that there is an investigation regarding allegations that I failed to report a foreign bank account to the Internal Revenue Service as required by 31 U.S.C. 5314.

5. My resignation is being submitted because I know that if charges were predicated upon the misconduct under investigation, I could not successfully defend against them.


