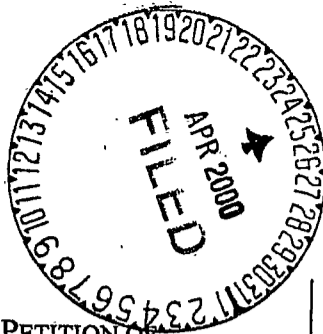

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

THIS MATTER is before the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a petition for reinstatement filed by Todd E. McCurry on April 14, 2000.

Based on a review of the records of the North Carolina State Bar, the Secretary makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Todd E. McCurry (hereafter "McCurry") was admitted to the North Carolina State Bar in 1987.
2. McCurry was suspended by the North Carolina State Bar by order dated March 16, 2000 for thirty days, which by the terms of the order ran from March 27, 2000 through April 25, 2000, file number 99 DHC 26 (the "Order").
3. On April 14, 2000, McCurry filed a verified petition for reinstatement in which he stated that he had complied with 27 N.C. Admin Code Chapter 1, SubChapter B, § .0124 of the State Bar Discipline and Disciplinary Rule, that he has complied with all orders of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission and the Council, and that he has abstained from the unauthorized practice of law during the period of suspension of his license.
4. The Office of Counsel of the North Carolina State Bar does not object to the reinstatement.

BASED on the foregoing FINDINGS OF FACT, the Secretary makes the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. The petitioner Todd E. McCurry has satisfied the requirements set out in 27 NC ADMIN CODE CHAPTER 1 SUBCHAPTER B § .0125, has complied with the conditions of the Discipline and Disability Rules of the North Carolina State Bar, and with the terms of the Order of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission dated March 16, 2000 file number 99 DHC 26, and is therefore entitled to reinstatement of his license to practice law in this jurisdiction.

Based on the foregoing FINDINGS OF FACT and CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, the Secretary enters the following:

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT


1. Todd E. McCurry is hereby reinstated to the active practice of law in North Carolina as of April 26, 2000.
