ORDER UNCONDITIONALLY
REINSTATING THE LAW LICENSE
OF JONATHAN A. McCOLLUM

On October 18, 2017, the State Bar Council entered an order conditionally reinstating the law license of Jonathan A. McCollum. The reinstatement was conditioned upon the following:

3. After the President enters a conditional order of reinstatement, McCollum must be in continual compliance with all requirements of the LAP contract until LAP certifies to the Council that McCollum has successfully completed and fulfilled all requirements of the LAP contract and has been discharged from LAP supervision.


On April 26, 2022, the Lawyer Assistance Program of the State Bar submitted to the Council a report containing the following information:

Jonathan A. McCollum entered into a contract with the Lawyer Assistance Program of the State Bar on October 2, 2017. McCollum was in continual compliance with all requirements of the LAP contract. The Lawyer Assistance Program hereby certifies to the State Bar Council that McCollum successfully completed and fulfilled all requirements of the LAP contract and was discharged from LAP supervision on April 15, 2022.

Jonathan A. McCollum has fulfilled all requirements of the October 18, 2017 order.

The Council therefore enters this order unconditionally reinstating the law license of Jonathan A. McCollum.
