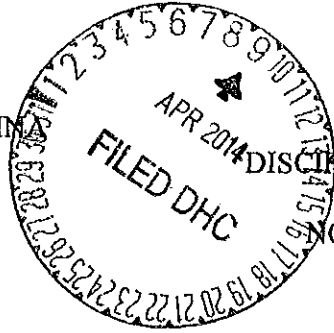

CONSENT ORDER
OF REINSTATEMENT

THIS MATTER was presented to a hearing panel of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission composed of Sharon B. Alexander, Chair, Renny W. Deese, and Randy A. Moreau upon the consent of the parties. Margaret Cloutier represented the North Carolina State Bar and Dudley A. Witt represented Defendant Ronna Dawn Gibbs. Based upon the parties' consent, the hearing panel makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By order entered December 1, 2005, the Chair of the Grievance Committee transferred Ronna Dawn Gibbs to disability inactive status.
2. On December 5, 2013, Philip H. Lavine, M. D. stated his opinion that Gibbs is in remission from major depression and does not currently suffer from post-traumatic stress symptoms. Dr. Lavine opined that Gibbs is fit to resume the practice of law.
3. On March 13, 2014, Gibbs filed a Petition for Reinstatement to Active Status.
4. The North Carolina State Bar does not have evidence contrary to the opinion of Dr. Levine.


BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact, the hearing panel enters the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This hearing panel has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter.
2. Gibbs has satisfied all of the conditions of 27 N.C.A.C. 1B §.0125(c)(3) to be eligible to return to active status.


THEREFORE, the hearing panel herewith GRANTS Gibbs' Petition for Reinstatement to Active Status.

Entered this the 9 day of April, 2014 with the knowledge and consent of the other members of the hearing panel.




