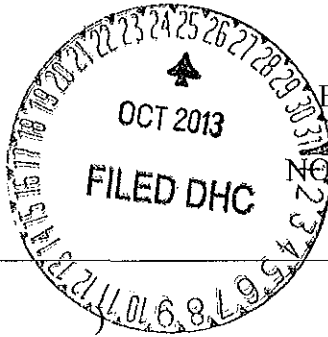

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

THIS MATTER is before the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a Petition for Reinstatement filed by Paul L. Erickson (“Erickson”) on September 24, 2013.

Based upon the petition and a review of the records of the North Carolina State Bar, the Secretary makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On August 14, 2008, a hearing panel of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission (“DHC”) entered Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order of Discipline in 07 DHC 17 (“Order of Discipline”) suspending Erickson from the practice of law for five years. The effective date of the Order of Discipline was October 9, 2008.

2. On September 24, 2013, Erickson filed a petition for reinstatement showing that he had satisfied the conditions of the Order of Discipline, although some of the conditions were not satisfied on a timely basis as set out in his petition.

3. Counsel for the North Carolina State Bar did not file an objection to Erickson’s petition.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Secretary makes the following

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Petitioner, Paul L. Erickson, has satisfied the requirements set out


in 27 NCAC 1B, § .0125(b) and is entitled to reinstatement of his license to practice law in this jurisdiction.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, the Secretary enters the following:

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Paul L. Erickson is hereby reinstated to the active practice of law in North Carolina as of the date of this order.
