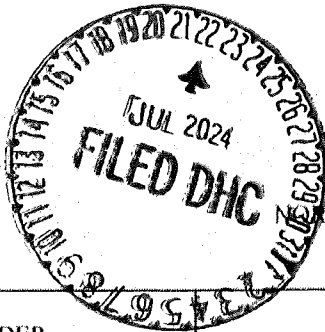

ORDER OF DISBARMENT

THIS MATTER coming on to be heard and being heard by the Council of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to 27 N.C. Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Subchapter B, Section .0121(a) of the State Bar Discipline & Disability Rules upon tender of an affidavit of surrender of license executed by Michael Glenn Wilson, II (hereinafter "Wilson") on 28 May 2024 and filed in the offices of the North Carolina State Bar on 15 July 2024.

Based upon the affidavit, the Council finds that Wilson misappropriated entrusted funds and funds belonging to his law firm Sigmon, Clark, Mackie, Hanvey & Farrell, PA (hereinafter "Sigmon Clark"), totaling no less than \$55,000, for his own personal use from March 2022 until January 2024. The Council finds that all misappropriated funds have since been returned to Sigmon Clark to be disbursed to their rightful owners. The Council further finds that Wilson has waived his rights to notice of this hearing and the right to be heard before the Council.

The Council thus concludes that the conduct of Michael Glenn Wilson, II is grounds for discipline under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 84-28(b)(2) in that Michael Glenn Wilson, II, violated Rules 1.15-2(a), 1.15-2(b), 1.15-2(c), 1.15-2(n), 8.4(c), and 8.4(d) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

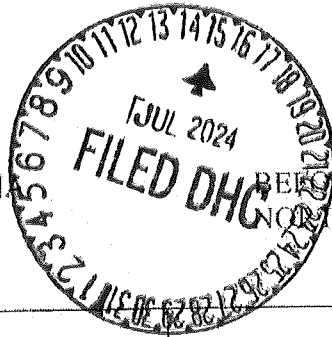
WHEREFORE, upon motion made and duly second, the Council enters the following Order:

1. The tender of surrender of license of Michael Glenn Wilson, II is hereby accepted.
2. Michael Glenn Wilson, II is hereby DISBARRED from the practice of law in North Carolina.
3. Wilson shall comply with the provisions of 27 N.C. Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Subchapter B, Section .0128 of the State Bar Discipline & Disability Rules. Wilson shall surrender his license and permanent membership card to the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar along with the affidavit required by 27 N. C. Admin. Code § 1B.0128 within 10 days of the entry of this order.
4. All administrative fees of this action are taxed against Wilson.

**AFFIDAVIT OF SURRENDER
OF LAW LICENSE**

Michael Glenn Wilson, II, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:


1. I desire to resign and hereby tender my license to practice law in North Carolina.
2. My resignation is freely and voluntarily rendered. It is not the result of coercion or duress. I am fully aware of the implication of submitting my resignation and have had the opportunity to discuss the evidence against me and possible defenses with counsel.
3. I am aware that there is a pending investigation against me that includes the following allegations:
 - a. From March 2022 until January 2024, I was employed as a partner in the firm of Sigmon, Clark, Mackie, Hanvey & Ferrell, PA (hereinafter "Sigmon Clark" in Hickory, North Carolina;
 - b. Prior to my employment at Sigmon Clark, I was employed as a partner at Wilson, Ramey & Fennell PLLC. That firm was dissolved in March 2022 by a dissolution filed with the North Carolina Secretary of State;
 - c. During my employment at Sigmon Clark, I continued to have access to the bank account(s) for Wilson, Ramey & Fennell PLLC.
 - d. While employed with Sigmon Clark, on multiple occasions, I misappropriated client entrusted funds, and funds belonging to Sigmon Clark, from Sigmon Clark's trust account for my personal use.
 - e. The total amount of funds I misappropriated for my personal use is no less than \$55,000.
 - f. I disbursed the misappropriated funds to myself for my own personal use via checks written to myself, to my former law partner at Wilson, Ramey & Fennell PLLC, or to my former law firm Wilson, Ramey & Fennell, PLLC in whole, and deposited those checks into Wilson, Ramey & Fennell PLLC's bank(s) account for my personal use;
4. As of the date of this affidavit, I have returned all funds that I misappropriated, and which are the subject of the State Bar's investigation, to Sigmon Clark to be disbursed to the rightful owners.

5. I acknowledge that the material facts upon which the allegations of the investigation are predicated are true.
6. I am submitting my resignation because I know that if disciplinary charges were predicated upon the misconduct under investigation, I could not successfully defend against them.
