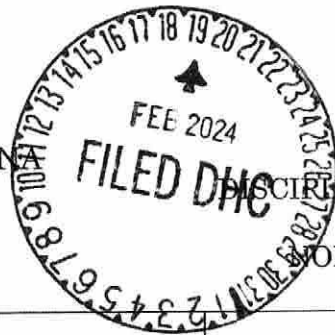

ORDER OF
REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a Petition for Reinstatement filed by Arnold O. Jones II on 9 January 2024.

Based upon the petition and a review of the records of the North Carolina State Bar, the Secretary makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On 25 October 2018 a hearing panel of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission (DHC) entered an Order of Discipline in 18 DHC 3 suspending Jones from the practice of law for five years, effective 20 December 2018.
2. On 9 January 2024 Jones filed a Petition for Reinstatement showing that he has substantially satisfied the conditions of the Order of Discipline.
3. Counsel for the North Carolina State Bar did not file an objection to Jones' petition.
4. Jones was eligible for reinstatement on 20 December 2024.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Secretary makes the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The petitioner, Arnold O. Jones II, has satisfied the conditions necessary for reinstatement set forth in the Order of Discipline.
2. The petitioner has met the requirements in 27 NCAC 1B, § .0129(b) and the provisions of the 25 October 2018 Order of Discipline.
3. The petitioner is entitled to reinstatement of his license to practice law in this jurisdiction.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Secretary enters the following:

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Arnold O. Jones II is hereby reinstated to the active practice of law in North Carolina as of the date of this order.
