This matter is before the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a petition for reinstatement filed on July 26, 1990 by Robert E. Griffin.

It appears from a review of the ORDER OF DISCIPLINE in 89 DHC 7 entered August 7, 1989 and filed on August 18, 1989 that the Petitioner was ordered suspended from the practice of law for six months. He was served with that order on August 23, 1989.

It further appears from his petition that the Petitioner has complied with:


1. Section 24 of Article IX, of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar;
2. The requirement of abstention from the unauthorized practice of law during the period of suspension.

After conducting necessary investigation regarding the Petitioner's compliance with the requirements set forth in Section 25(B)(3) of Article IX of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar, Counsel for the North Carolina State Bar filed no objection to the petition within the time required by Section 25(B)(4) of Article IX.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 25(B)(5) of Article IX of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina State Bar, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Robert E. Griffin is reinstated to the active practice of law in North Carolina on this date.
2. His license certificate should be returned to him forthwith.
