CONSENT ORDER
FOR REINSTATEMENT
FROM SUSPENSION

This matter was considered by a Hearing Panel of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission composed of Joshua W. Willey, Jr., Chair, Allison Mullins, and Kimberly W. Strach. Plaintiff was represented by Savannah P. McLamb. Defendant, Emily Moore Tyler (“Tyler”), appeared pro se. The parties stipulate to the findings of fact set forth herein.

Based upon the pleadings in this matter, the parties’ stipulations of fact, and with the consent of the parties, the Hearing Panel hereby finds by clear, cogent, and convincing evidence the following:

Findings of Fact

1. By Consent Order of Discipline entered 7 April 2020, Tyler was suspended for five years from the practice of law, effective 17 May 2020.
2. As of 17 May 2025, Tyler served five years of active suspension.
3. On 30 April 2025, Tyler filed a verified petition seeking reinstatement to active status.
4. In her petition, Tyler verified that she had satisfied all conditions for reinstatement set out in the Consent Order of Discipline.
5. Tyler substantially complied with the requirements of 27 N.C.A.C. 1B § .0129(b) and the conditions in the Consent Order of Discipline, notwithstanding:
 - a. That Tyler did not notify clients represented in pending matters of the reasons for her suspension, as 27 N.C.A.C. 1B § .0128(a) requires; and

- b. That Tyler did not complete one hour of CLE devoted to technology for her 2024 CLE requirements. Tyler promptly completed an online CLE to satisfy that requirement when the deficit was brought to her attention.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Hearing Panel hereby makes the following:


Conclusions of Law

1. All parties are properly before the Disciplinary Hearing Commission and the Disciplinary Hearing Commission has jurisdiction over Defendant, Emily C. Moore Tyler, and the subject matter of this proceeding.

2. Defendant, Emily C. Moore Tyler, has substantially satisfied the requirements set out in Rule .0129(b) of the North Carolina State Bar Discipline and Disability Rules and the conditions in the Consent Order of Discipline for reinstatement from suspension.


THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED Tyler's 30 April 2025 verified petition for reinstatement is ALLOWED and she shall be permitted to resume practicing law effective 2 June 2025.


